- 1 Apply [Apricot Twist cream eye color](#) all over the eyelids. Apply [Iced Cocoa cream eye color](#) along upper and lower lashlines. Line upper and lower lashlines with [Mary Kay Deep Brown eyeliner](#) and smudge using the eye smudger brush.
- 2 Sweep on two coats of [Lash Love Mascara in I  \$\square\$  black](#).
- 3 Apply [Light-Medium bronzing powder](#) to the cheekbones, temples and jawline, applying what's left on the brush to the apples of the cheeks.
- 4 Finish the look with [True Dimensions Lipstick in Berry a la Mode](#) and [Nour-iShine Plus Lip Gloss in Silver Moon](#) for a crushed berry, bitten lip look.
